### **Agenda item No. 3**

#### **Application dated 28.02.2019 of Dr. Shoukath Ali, P.K. Ex-Inspector of his Council regarding permission to join any Homoeopathic Institution after retirement.**

The Executive Committee considered the offer letter for the post of Professor in Department of Homoeopathic Pharmacy in Rani Dullaiya Smriti Homoeopathy Medical College & Hospital, Bhopal and also noted that there is no litigation of CCH with said college. Therefore, the Executive Committee decided to issue no objection to Dr. Shoukath Ali, P.K., former Inspector of the Council.

However, Dr.(Mrs.) Anil Kumari Malhotra, Member, expressed her disagreement to said decision on the ground that the proposed salary of Rs.1,00,000/- is excessive.

### **Agenda item No. 4**

#### **Payment of NPS Contribution (Government) at an enhanced rate.**

The Executive Committee considered Notification dated 31.01.2019 of Ministry of Finance for enhancement of Government Contribution from 10% to 14 % for the employees who are in NPS w.e.f. 01.04.2019, and it agreed for its implementation.

### **Agenda item No. 5**

#### **Email dated 20.04.2019 of Shri Sunil Narula, Advocate regarding his appointment as Panel Counsel of CCH.**

The Executive Committee discussed the matter and considered the request of Shri Sunil Narula, Retainer Advocate of this Council for his appointment as Panel Counsel of CCH for High Court of Delhi. It also noted that CCIM has also appointed its Panel Counsels for High Court of Delhi. Shri Vats, Asstt. Secretary (Admn.), apprised that CCRH has appointed Shri Narula as Retainer Advocate and court cases are also assigned to him by CCRH, from time to time. This was also confirmed by Shri Anil Khurana, Member, Executive Committee and DDG, CCRH.

Considering Sh. Narula's long experience of 34 years as well as his association with CCH since 2012, the Executive Committee decided to appoint him Panel Counsel for High Court of Delhi. However, wherever required, and based upon the circumstances of a case, the Council reserves the right to assign any court case to other advocate(s) too, who are on the panel of Govt. of India.

The Executive Committee also decided that miscellaneous and out of pocket expenses (if any) claimed by the advocates, will also be paid as per actual expenditure subject to a maximum of Rs.3,000/- per case, as quantum of payable amount has not been fixed under table 'B' of O.M. dated 01.10.2015 issued by Ministry of Law & Justice, Government of India.

#### **Request of Mr. Shubham Dubey. A. from Sai Homoeopathic Medical College Bhiwandi to Virar Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Virar for grant of permission for transfer of migration.**
