Sub:-Applications of Existing Homoeopathic Medical Colleges under section 12C of HCC Act, 1973- forwarding of application reg.

Madam/Sir,


On the subject cited above, I am directed to say that as per section 12C of the amended Act 2018, all existing colleges established under section 12A of the Act and colleges and their hospitals established prior to 28th January, 2003 had to apply to the Central Government in prescribed format according to notified provisions of Homoeopathy Central Council (Minimum Standards Requirement of Homoeopathic Colleges and attached Hospitals) Amendment Regulation 2019, but no applications has been received so far.

2. Furthermore the Central Govt. in consultation with Ministry of Law & Justice, has opined that provisions of MSR Regulations are applicable and all existing Homoeopathy colleges are bound by the terms and conditions and modalities including prescribed fees for seeking the permission of the Central Government (copy enclosed).

3. Therefore, you are requested to apply in prescribed format along with required application fees to the Central Govt. latest by 30th November 2019 and seek permission or else the provisions of Section 12B of the Act shall apply to the Homoeopathic Medical Colleges which fail to seek and obtain permission. Please ignore this letter if already applied.

Subject: - Applications of existing Homoeopathic Colleges u/s 12C of HCC Act, 1973 forwarding of application - reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter no 15-06/2019-CCH-4690 dated 21st August, 2019 on the above mentioned subject and to state that, the matter has been examined in consultation with the Ministry of Law and Justice about the feasibility of extension of date for seeking permission of the Central Government from 17th May, 2019 to 31st December, 2019.

2. In this regard, the Ministry of Law and Justice observed that extension of the time from 17th May 2019 to 31st December, 2019 as prescribed in Section 12C of HCC Act, 1973 would only be possible through bringing another amendment. Further, the Ministry of Law and Justice has opined that Section 12C (only provide that existing colleges shall seek permission of the Central Government in accordance with the Amendment Regulations made by the CCH) which necessarily means provisions contained in the MSR Regulations 2013 as well as Amendment Regulations (which were notified on 20.4.2019) prior to threshold time limit provided in the Act, i.e 17th May, 2019. (Since MSR Regulations were notified prior to 17th May 2019, provisions of MSR Regulations would be applicable and all existing Homoeopathy colleges are bound by the terms and conditions and modalities including prescribed fees for seeking the permissions of the Central Government.))

3. In view of above, CCH is requested to (ensure that all existing Homoeopathic colleges immediately apply to the Central Government along with the requisite fees, in compliance with Homoeopathic Central Council (Minimum Standards of Requirement of Homeopathic Colleges and attached hospital) Regulations, 2013 and Amended Regulation 2019 as notified on 29.4.2019.)
