The First Schedule

The Central Government shall, by notification in the Official Gazette, determine the number of seats allocated in the Central Council of Homoeopathy in each State on the following basis, namely:

(a)	Where the number of persons enrolled on a State Register of Homoeopathy system exceeds 100 but does not exceed 10,000	1 Seat
(b)	Where the number of persons enrolled on a State Register of Homoeopathy system exceeds 10,000 but does not exceed 20,000	2 seat.
(c)	Where the number of persons enrolled on a State Register of Homoeopathy system exceed 20,000 but does not exceed 30,000	3 seat
(d)	Where the number of persons enrolled on a State Register of Homoeopathy system exceeds 30,000 but does not exceed 40,000	4 seat
(e)	Where the number of persons enrolled on a State Register of Homoeopathy system exceeds 40,000	5 seat

2.For every subsequent election to the Central Council under clause (a) of sub-section (1) of section 3, the Central Government shall, by notification in the Official Gazette, determine the number of seats allocated in the Central Council of Homoeopathy on the basis laid down in paragraph 1 above.
