Sub:- Implementation of reservation of 10% seats for the Economically Weaker Section (EWS) candidates by enhancing Under graduate and Post graduate seats in the existing Government Medical Colleges/Institutes u/s 12A of the HCC Act, 1973 from the academic year 2020-21.

Madam/Sir,


With reference to office memorandum dated 17.01.2019 of the Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development referred at serial no. 2 of reference on the subject cited above, with regard to implementation of reservation for EWS for admission to Under graduate and Post graduate courses in Government Medical Colleges under the control of Central and State Government, I am to request you to send your proposal under the EWS Scheme in consultation with Department of Medical Education (if required) u/s using 12A of the HCC Act, 1973, for the academic year 2020-21 not later than 15th June, 2019. In this proposal, the increase of 10% EWS quota should be on the seats that stand recognized on the day of submission of the proposal.

The proposals for increase of seats U/s 12A of the HCC Act, 1973 (Regular Application process for Increase of Seats other than EWS) as envisaged under the Establishment of New Medical College, (Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College) Regulation, 2011 (as amended upto 2018) should be made separately.

Colleges are required to ensure that the additional facility required for the increase as per the Homoeopathy Central Council (Minimum Standards of Requirement of Homoeopathic Colleges and Attached Hospitals), Regulations, 2013 (as amended upto 2019) shall be put in place by the time the said increase in intake capacity of the college comes up for recognition. The college-wise BHMS/MD(Hom.) seat increase proposal to the Board of Governors, CCH should be received in the Council office not later than 15th June, 2019.

You are further requested to furnish the course-wise seat increase matrix along with relevant information as per the enclosed format.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) for admission in Central Educational Institutions - reg.

The Undersigned is directed to **enclose** herewith the copy of OM dated 17.01.2019 of the Ministry of Human Resource Development for implementation of reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) in admission to educational institutions from academic year 2019-20 onwards for students/candidates who are not covered under the existing schemes of reservation of SC/ST/OBC and as per the mandate of the Constitution (One Hundred and Third Amendment) Act, 2019 to say:

- a) The reservations shall be provided to EWSs for admission in Central Educational Institutions, (as defined in clause (d) of section (2) of The Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006) from the academic year 2019-20 onwards.
- b) The above reservation would not be applicable to the 8 institutions of excellence, research institutions, institutions of national & strategic importance as specified in the Schedule to The Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006, as amended from time to time and to the minority educational institutions referred to in clause (1) of article 30 of the Constitution.
- c) Every Central Educational Institution shall, with the prior approval of the appropriate authority (as defined in clause (c) of section 2 of The Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006), increase the number of seats over and above its annual permitted strength in each branch of study or faculty so that the number of seats available, excluding those reserved for the persons belonging to the EWSs, is not less than the number of such seats available, in each category, for the academic session immediately preceding the date of the coming into force of these guidelines.

d) The applicability of this Amendment Act, 2019 for the increase of annual permitted strength need to be implemented from the academic year following the commencement of the Amendment Act but in case the annual permitted strength cannot be implemented for reasons of financial, physical or academic limitation or in order to maintain the standards of education, such increase can be implemented over a period of two years beginning with the academic session 2019-20, after the representation by the Central Education Institution to the appropriate authority and subject to its satisfaction on the grounds as stated above. At any stage of implementation of EWS reservation, the number and percentage of reservation provided for SC/ST/OBC categories shall not be reduced.

2. In view of the above, CCIM/CCH are requested to take all necessary measures including enabling amendment in the Regulation to facilitate implementation of the provision of the constitution (Amendment) Act, 2019 with immediate effect and also to write to all Central Universities/National Institutions and all State Govt. / Union territories authorities to send proposal under the 10% increase in UG and PG courses for EWS scheme in consultation with concerned Government Institution within time frame, so that it can be implemented from the Academic session 2020-21.

3. This issues with the approval of the Hon'ble MoS (IC), Ministry of AYUSH.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) for admission in Central Educational Institutions.

In accordance with the provisions of the Constitution (One Hundred and Third Amendment) Act 2019, and the reference of Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment vide OM No. 20013/01/2018-BC-II dated 17th January 2019, enabling provision of reservation for the Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservations for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes, it has been decided to provide reservation in admission to educational institutions subject to a maximum of ten per cent of the total seats in each category. This would not apply to the minority educational institutions referred to in clause (1) of Article 30 of the Constitution of India.

2. The provision of reservations to the Economically Weaker Sections shall be in accordance with the directions contained in the OM No. 20013/01/2018-BC-II dated 17th January 2019 of the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment and shall be subject to the following:

- a) The reservations shall be provided to EWSs for admission in Central Educational Institutions, (as defined in clause (d) of section (2) of The Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006) from the academic year 2019-20 onwards.
- b) The above reservation would not be applicable to the 8 institutions of excellence, research institutions, institutions of national & strategic importance as specified in the Schedule to The Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006, as amended from time to time, and appended to this OM, and to the minority educational institutions referred to in clause (1) of article 30 of the Constitution.
- c) Every Central Educational Institution shall, with the prior approval of the appropriate authority (as defined in clause (c) of section 2 of The Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006) increase the number of seats over and above its annual permitted strength in each branch of

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
study or faculty so that the number of seats available, excluding those reserved for the persons belonging to the EWSs, is not less than the number of such seats available, in each category, for the academic session immediately preceding the date of the coming into force of this O.M.

- d) Where, on a representation by any Central Educational Institution, the appropriate authority is satisfied that for reasons of financial, physical or academic limitations or in order to maintain the standards of education, the annual permitted strength in any branch of study or faculty of such institution cannot be increased for the academic session following the commencement of this Act, it may permit such institution to increase the annual permitted strength over a maximum period of two years beginning with the academic session following the commencement of this Act; and then, the extent of reservation for the Economically Weaker Sections shall be limited for that academic session in such manner that the number of seats made available to the Economically Weaker Sections for each academic session shall not reduce the number and the percentage of reservations provided for SC/ST/OBC categories.
- e) The scheme for implementing the reservation for the EWS shall be displayed on the website of the institution as soon as possible, but no later than 31st March 2019.

3. The Chairman UGC, Chairman AICTE and Chairperson NCTE and the Bureau Heads of the Department of Higher Education in the Ministry of Human Resource Development responsible for management of the Institutions of National Importance are requested to ensure immediate compliance of this OM.

4. This issues with the approval of the Minister for Human Resource Development.
