CENTRAL COUNCIL OF HOMOEOPATHY

ANNUAL REPORT 1984-85

The Central Council of Homoeopathy presents its 11th Annual Report for the year 1984-85.

The Central Council considered the comments received from the State Govts. on the draft Postgraduate Courses in Homoeopathy as per provisions of Sub-Section (2) of Section 20 of Homoeopathic Central Council Act, 1973 and finalised the same. The Postgraduate Courses in Homoeopathy have been forwarded to the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi for according necessary approval as Regulations under the provisions of the Homoeopathic Central Council Act, 1973.

Consequent on the implementation of Educational Regulations prescribed by the Central Council, the Council has been receiving references asking for clarification in regard to certain provisions of the Educational Regulations for diploma and degree courses for which the Council has appointed a sub-committee to suggest amendments.

The Central Council of Homoeopathy also appointed a Sub-Committee to suggest suitable amendments in the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 on the experience gained so far.

During the year under review the Council has recommended to the Central Government the following qualifications

for their inclusion in Second Schedule to Homoeopathic Central Council Act, 1973 :—

1. B.H.M.S. awarded by the Calcutta University upto 31.12.1988.
2. D.H.M.S. awarded by the Board of Homoeopathic System of Medicine, Assam, under the Assam Homoeopathy (Diploma Course) Regulations 1982, upto 31st December, 1986.
3. D.H.M.S. awarded by Rajahmundry Homoeopathic Medical College, Rajahmundry upto 31st December, 1986.

During the year under review, inspections of Homoeopathic Medical Colleges in the States of Assam, Tamilnadu, Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka and National Institute of Homoeopathy, Calcutta were carried out.

The Central Council recommended that the Central Govt. may pass a statute so that the N. I. H. may achieve its independent status and award its own degrees itself and till that status is not achieved the status-quo may be maintained.

The Council has recommended the pay structure of the teachers possessing 4 years diploma qualification in Homoeopathy and having five years or more teaching experience should be given the University Grant Commission pay scales as is prevalent for the teaching staff of other medical institutions.

The Council also approved the recommendation of the Education Committee for inclusion of Drug Proving in the guidelines for compulsory internship for degree course.

The Central Council adopted the recruitment rules for various posts in the Council as approved by the Government of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi.

The work relating to maintenance of Central Register of Homoeopathy in accordance with the provisions of Homoeopathy Central Council (Registration) Regulation 1982, has been started. Efforts are being made to get the Central Register published in the Gazette of India. The Council has entertained 112 requests for direct enrolment in the Central Register during 1984-85.

During the year under review, one meeting of the Central Council, three meetings of the Executive Committee, three meetings of Education Committee, one meeting of the Finance Committee, One meeting of Sub-Committee to consider matters of legal importance, one meeting of Sub-Committee to suggest remedial measures for the difficulties in the implementation of Educational Regulation and one meeting of the Sub-Committee to suggest amendments in the Homoeopathic Central Council Act, 1973 were held.

The Council approved statement of accounts of the Council for the year 1983-84 for annual audit and certification as forwarded to Directorate of Audit, Central Revenues, New Delhi.

The Council considered and approved the proposals for (i) Revised Estimates for the year 1984-85 Rs 5.68 lakhs (Plan) (ii) Rs. 3.36 lakhs (Non-Plan), (iii) Budget Estimates for the year 1985-86 Rs. 5.00 lakhs (Plan) (iv) Rs. 11.00 lakhs (Non-Plan), (v) Annual Plan for the year 1985-86 for Rs. 5.00 lakhs and (vi) VIIth Five Year Plan 1985-90 for Rs. 40.00 lakhs.

Statement of accounts for the year 1984-85 as audited by the Director of Audit, Central Revenue is annexed to this report.

AUDIT REPORT ON THE CENTRAL COUNCIL OF HOMOEOPATHY FOR THE YEAR 1984-85.

1. General

The Central Council of Homoeopathy was established in 1973-74 as a statutory body under the Homoeopathy Central Act, 1973. The Council is mainly financed by grants from the Government of India. During 1984-85, the Council had received grants amounting to Rs. 7.11 lakhs (plan Rs. 4.00 lakhs and Non-Plan Rs. 3.11 lakhs).

2. Annual Accounts

2.1. An amount of Rs. 80,622/- being cost of unsold publications at the close of the year was shown in the Balance Sheet as on 31st March, 1984. The value of such unsold publications costing Rs. 78,890/- as on 31st March, 1985 has, however, not been shown in the Balance Sheet. Reasons for non accountal of the cost of unsold publications was also not explained by any foot note in the Balance Sheet.

2.2. As on 31st March, 1985, the Institute had acquired assets valued at Rs. 4,24,463.94 out of government grants. The Institute did not maintain any assets register in form GFR 19 as required under rules till 1983-84. The asset register maintained from 1984-85 did not give any details of the assets acquired from time to time. The Council stated (August 1985) that the requisite details of assets as shown in the balance sheet were being collected and would be shown in next audit. In the absence of proper records, the financial

value of assets as reflected in the accounts was not susceptible of reconciliation and verification.

2.3 The Council had invested Rs. 1,20,000/- in fixed deposit account in the bank out of accumulation of Rs. 1,47,148.30 in the CPF Account available as on 31st March 1985. The Council has not followed the investment-pattern prescribed by the Government although it was pointed out in the earlier Inspection Report.

2.4. The Council has paid leave salary amounting to Rs. 7,354.55 to the deputationists during 1978-79 to 1982-83 which was recoverable from the parent offices of the deputationists. The same should have been shown as such in the balance sheet on the asset side as on 31st March, 1985.

The Council stated (August 1985) that efforts were being made to recover the amount.
