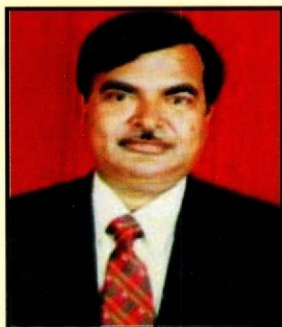

The Central Council of Homoeopathy organized a workshop on conduct of Council's business for its members (in two batches) on 27th and 28th August 2009 at New Delhi. Dr. Ramjee Singh, President of the Council, inaugurated the workshop, wherein Dr. Arun N. Bhasme, Vice-President, CCH, addressed the gathering and Dr. Lalit Verma, Secretary, CCH extended a warm welcome to the members. Dr. Verma also gave a brief account on the history of the Council and discussed the need of the workshop. Dr. Diwan Harish Chand, presently a member and the former Vice-President of the Council, addressed the august gathering on 27th August, 2009 and extended his blessings. Dr. Kamala Kanta Kar, Member also addressed the members on 28th August, 2009. The speakers included - Dr. A.D. Kothe, Dr. G.B. Dhadphale, Dr. S. M. Desarda and Dr. Narayan Debnath. Dr. Lalit Verma, Secretary, CCH also made a presentation. Dr. Ashis Datta, Asstt. Secretary (Tech.) and Sh. H.D. Rikhadi, Asstt. Secretary (A&R) welcomed the members by presenting 'Red Rose'. PUBLICATION OF CENTRAL REGISTER OF HOMOEOPATHY

The entries of Kerala State Register of Homoeopathy and the practitioners registered directly with CCH (up to August 2009) have been included in the Central Register of Homoeopathy (C.R.H.), which has been sent to Govt. Press on 10th July 2009, for publication in the Official Gazette of Govt. of India.

RENEWAL OF CENTRAL REGISTER OF HOMOEOPATHY

The Central Register of Homoeopathy which was notified in Gazette in 1996, has been updated and sent to Govt. Publication Department.

DIRECT REGISTRATION

The Council entertains application for direct registration from the homoeopathic practitioners

holding recognized medical qualification and registration with the state council. Central Council of Homoeopathy has issued Direct Registration Certificates to 56 applicants (from April to September 2009).

SUBJECT-WISE WORKSHOP FOR THE TEACHERS OF HOMOEOPATHIC MEDICAL COLLEGES


Central Council of Homoeopathy conducted its first ever subject-wise workshop on Anatomy on 25th & 26th June, 2009 at New Delhi. The resource persons were Dr. (Mrs) Pushpa Dhar, Professor, AIIMS, New Delhi; Dr. V.K. Chauhan, Principal, Dr. B. R. Sur Homoeopathic Medical College & Research Center, New Delhi; Dr. Gautam Ash, Reader, National Institute of Homoeopathy, Kolkata; Dr. Ajay Singh Parihar, Reader, Govt. Homoeopathic Medical College, Bhopal and Dr. S. J. Engineer, Professor, Shri Kamaxi Devi Homoeopathic Medical College, Shiroda. In total, 15 teachers of Anatomy from different Homoeopathic Medical Colleges of the country participated in the workshop.

RECOGNITION OF QUALIFICATIONS

The Central Council of Homoeopathy has recommended for recognition of following qualifications to the Central Government :

1. B.H.M.S. qualification of Guwahati University.
2. B.H.M.S. (Graded) Qualification of West Bengal University of Health Sciences.
3. M.D. (Hom.) qualification of West Bengal University of Health Sciences, in respect of 3 Specialities namely, Homoeopathic Materia Medica, Organon & Homoeopathic Philosophy and Repertory.
4. M.D. (Hom.) qualification of University of Pune, in respect of 4 Specialities namely, Homoeopathic Materia Medica, Organon & Homoeopathic Philosophy and Repertory.

5. M.D. (Hom.) qualification of University of Mumbai, in respect of 3 Specialities namely, Practice of Medicine, Psychiatry and Paediatrics.
 6. M.D. (Hom.) qualification of Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik, in respect of 7 Specialties namely, Homoeopathic Materia Medica, Organon & Homoeopathic Philosophy, Repertory, Homoeopathic Pharmacy, Practice of Medicine, Psychiatry and Paediatrics.

INSPECTION OF HOMOEOPATHIC MEDICAL COLLEGES

The Central Council of Homoeopathy inspected 34 Homoeopathic Medical Colleges (from April to September 2009) during the financial year 2009-10 to assess the facilities and standards of education.

C.C.H CONDEMNS THE STATEMENT OF W.H.O. AGAINST HOMOEOPATHIC TREATMENT

The Central Council of Homoeopathy constituted a Committee for discussing the statement of W.H.O. published in various newspapers against homoeopathic treatment for Malaria, T.B., Influenza, H.I.V. Infection and Diarrhoea. The Committee had Dr. S.P. Singh as Chairman and Dr. Diwan Harish Chand, Dr Chaturbhuja Nayak, Dr. K.K. Juneja and Dr. V.K. Khanna as members.

The Committee considered the various news reports that quoted W.H.O. authorities advising against homeopathic treatment for the above mentioned disease conditions. The Committee noted that with the financial support of the Central/State Govts., the institutions like Central Council for Research in Homoeopathy, Nation Institute of Homoeopathy and Delhi Homoeopathic Research Council have been conducting researches on the role of Homoeopathy in the diseases cited above, with encouraging results, supported by records and data.


The Committee felt that without understanding the basic principles of homoeopathic treatment, publication of such news items quoting authorities like W.H.O., may create panic, not only among the young homoeopathic doctors but also among the general public at large. Therefore, it proposed that CCH may write to W.H.O. local authorities in the matter by giving a sufficient background, with a copy to the Central Govt. and to different Govt. agencies, seeking confirmation of the quoted statement of W.H.O. authority with supporting data, if any, with them. The committee also decided to request the W.H.O. authorities not to give such vague statements against various recognized streams of medicine which have large following and proven efficacy. Accordingly action has been taken by CCH.

CCH RECOMMENDS FOR PREVENTIVE IN PANDEMIC VIRAL FLU RESEMBLING SWINE FLU

The Committee constituted by CCH to consider the adverse statement of W.H.O. published in news papers against homoeopathic treatment also discussed the emerging picture of Viral Flu pandemic resembling Swine Flu. The experts present in the meeting included Dr. S.P.Singh, Dr. V.K. Khanna & Dr. K.K. Juneja recommended that Arsenicum album 30 could be used as a preventive by giving for 4 days (2 doses daily) and can be repeated after 15-20 days if fresh cases are observed in the locality. The said medicine is non-toxic and free from side-effects.

In case the disease affects a person, he or she must contact a registered homoeopathic practitioner, as there are effective homoeopathic medicines for its treatment.

The Executive Committee of the Council, in its meeting held on 30th Sep. 2009, has accepted the recommendation of the above Committee and it decided to inform the Central Govt. about the preventive medicine in Homoeopathy, recommended for viral flu resembling Swine Flu and also agreed to take up the matter with WHO authority.



CCH PAYS TRIBUTE TO LATE DR. K.K. RAJENDRAN

CCH WITH NIH COLLABORATES FOR THE INTERNATIONAL HOMOEOPATHIC SEMINAR

Dr. Ramjee Singh, the President of CCH, attended a meeting on 26th August 2009 at the National Institute of Homoeopathy, Kolkata to discuss the details of the proposed International Seminar organized by NIH, in February, 2010 on 'Recent Advances in Homoeopathy'. It was decided to have Central Council of Homoeopathy, Central Council for Research in Homoeopathy and Homoeopathic Pharmacopoeia Laboratory, as partner institutions for the said programme. It was also decided to form different committees with the representatives from different departments of AYUSH/CCRH /CCH/ NIH/HPL and homoeopathic profession. Apart from these committees, there will be one International Committee, consisting of one/two representatives from major countries.

The Executive Committee of Central Council of Homoeopathy appreciated the proposal to conduct the International Seminar at Kolkata and declared it as a progressive step by NIH, Kolkata in association with Department of AYUSH, Govt. of India.
