Central Council of Homoeopathy organized one day workshop on the subject "HOMOEOPATHIC HOSPITAL MANAGEMENT" for the Principals/Superintendents/Deputy Superintendents of Homoeopathic Medical Colleges and Hospitals on 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2011 in the auditorium of Nehru Homoeopathic Medical College, Defence Colony, New Delhi.

The objectives of the workshop were to discuss about bringing improvement in:

- 1) providing the services to the patients in the Homoeopathic Hospitals attached to Homoeopathic Medical Colleges;
- 2) managing attitudes and technical skills in the clinical teaching and training to the Under Graduate and Post Graduate students in Homoeopathy.

Dr. Lalit Verma, Secretary, CCH gave the welcome address.

Dr. Arun N. Bhasme, Vice-President, presided over the inaugural session and addressed the participants.

The workshop was inaugurated by the President of the Central Council, Dr. Ramjee Singh. In his inaugural address, he highlighted the need of this workshop as the Council has been observing that some of the hospitals attached to Homoeopathic Colleges are poorly managed and under utilized.

## MEETINGS OF CENTRAL COUNCIL OF HOMOEOPATHY AND ITS COMMITTEES

During the period from Oct to Dec, 2011, Central Council of Homoeopathy met on 21.10.2011 and its different Committees held their respective meetings including one meeting of Executive Committee, one meeting of Education Committee, one meeting of Committee for Excellence in Education in Homoeopathy. One special Committee constituted by President, CCH also had its meeting to discuss about the amendments in Homoeopathy (Minimum Standards of Education) Regulations.

### DIRECT REGISTRATION BY C.C.H.

The Council received 98 applications for direct registration from the homoeopathic practitioners holding recognized medical qualification, and registration with the State Boards/Councils. Central Council has issued Direct Registration Certificates to 121 applicants (from Oct to Dec, 2011).

### INSPECTION OF HOMOEOPATHIC MEDICAL COLLEGES

The Central Council of Homoeopathy inspected 86 Homoeopathic Medical Colleges during the period under report to monitor the extent the minimum required facilities and standards of education are met by them.

## THE INDIAN HOMOEOPATHIC LEGEND

### DR. DIWAN HARISHCHAND IS NO MORE

The world's renowned Homoeopath Dr. Diwan Harish Chand, sitting member of CCH has passed away in the morning of 13<sup>th</sup> December, 2011. Dr. Diwan Harish Chand graduated in Medicine (M.B.B.S.) in 1945 and successfully completed M.F.(Hom) from Royal London Homoeopathic Hospital, London.

He was nominated as a member to the C.C.H from August 1974 to 4<sup>th</sup> February, 1991 and from 20<sup>th</sup> January, 2006 till he expired. He was the first elected Vice-President of this Central Council from 1<sup>st</sup> August, 1976 to 4<sup>th</sup> February, 1991. During his long 60 years of practice in Homoeopathy he was honoured with more than 20 awards including the most prestigious award in Medicine "Dhanwantari" having been adjudged "the most outstanding medical man of the year". He was awarded by Govt. of Delhi with "Homoeo Rattan". Besides, he had been the Chairman of Homoeopathic Pharmacopoeia Committee of Govt. of India; Chairman of Scientific Advisory Committee, Central Council for Research in Homoeopathy. Dr. Diwan Harish Chand was the honorary physician to the President of India and also the third Honorary Advisor (Homoeopathy) to Govt. of India. His literary works are the priceless contributions like : A Compendium of Lectures on Homoeopathy; Micro-doses Mega-results; Homoeopathy in Geriatrics, and Iconography of Hahnemann. He was the Co-editor with Pierre Schimdt for Kent's Final General Repertory. He was the Honorary Professor at Nehru Homoeopathic Medical College, Govt. of Delhi. He had keen interest in sports, photography and philately. The passing away of Dr. Diwan Harish Chand is an irreparable loss to the Homoeopathic fraternity not only of India but of the world at large.

## INTERNATIONAL LIGA CONGRESS AT NEW DELHI

The 66th World Homoeopathic Congress, 2011 was organized by LMHI, India Chapter, (where Central Council of Homoeopathy was one of the collaborators) in Sirifort Auditorium at New Delhi from 1-4 December, 2011. The Congress was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Minister of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India, Sh. Ghulam Nabi Azad. The theme of the Congress was "Homoeopathy for Public Health".

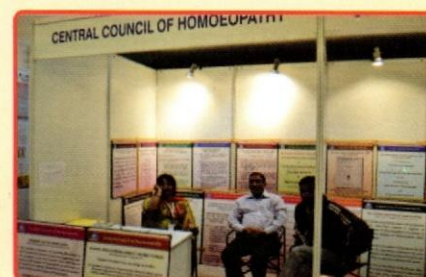
