


Vote of thanks was extended by Dr. Ashis Datta, Assistant Secretary (Technical), CCH.

## **INSPECTION OF HOMOEOPATHIC MEDICAL COLLEGES**


The Central Council of Homoeopathy during the period from 1st April to 30th June, 2012, inspected 17 Homoeopathic Medical Colleges and one centre of BHMS examination of a University to monitor the extent to which minimum required facilities and standards of education are met by them.

## **MEETINGS OF CCH AND ITS COMMITTEES**

During the period from April to June, 2012 different Committees of Central Council of Homoeopathy held their respective meetings including 1 meeting of Executive Committee, 1 meeting of Education Committee, 2 meetings of P.G. Education Committee besides 1 meeting regarding amendments to Homoeopathy (Minimum Standards of Education) Regulations.

## **DIRECT REGISTRATION BY C.C.H.**

During the first quarter of 2012-13, the Council received 91 applications for direct registration from the homoeopathic practitioners holding recognized medical qualification, and registration with the State Boards/Councils, and it issued direct Registration Certificates to 55 applicants.
