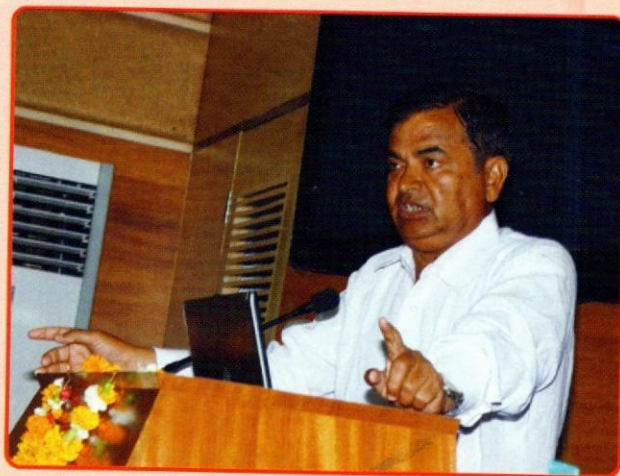
Dr. Ashis Datta, Assistant Secretary (Technical) extended the vote of thanks.

DIRECT REGISTRATION BY C.C.H.

During the second quarter of 2012-13, the Council received 95 applications for direct registration from the homoeopathic practitioners holding recognized medical qualification and registration with the State Boards/Councils, and it has issued Direct Registration Certificates to 86 applicants.

INSPECTION OF HOMOEOPATHIC MEDICAL COLLEGES

The Central Council of Homoeopathy inspected 34 Homoeopathic Medical Colleges during the period under report to monitor the extent the minimum required facilities and standards of education are met by them.

ASSISTANT SECRETARY (TECHNICAL) OF CCH VISITED BANGLADESH

Department of AYUSH, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India deputed a team of Homoeopathic Experts consisting of Dr. Ashis Datta, Assistant Secretary (Technical) of Central Council of Homoeopathy and Dr. Kumar Vivekanand, Research Officer of Central Council for Research in Homoeopathy for a weeklong visit from July 15, 2012 in order to have a proper study about Homoeopathic education, research and practice in Bangladesh.

The Homoeopathic Experts visited the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare of Govt. of People's Republic of Bangladesh and met the Addl. Secretary, Janab Aminul Islam Laskar. The team apprised him about the Homoeopathic educational policy, research and practice in India. The Addl. Secretary had shown his willingness to visit the educational institute of Homoeopathy in India, particularly the colleges at Delhi and National Institute of Homoeopathy at Kolkata. During the discussion Sh. Subhash Chandra Sarkar, Joint Secretary (Health) and Dr. Asma Akhtar Jahan, Deputy Secretary (Health) of Bangladesh were present.

The team visited the Office of the Director General of Health and met Addl. Director General (Health), Prof. (Dr.) A.S.M. Saiful Islam. Addl.

Director General (Health) welcome the Indian team and discussed about the matter of recognition of Homoeopathic qualifications (awarded in Bangladesh) in India. He also requested the Indian experts to convey his request to the authorities of Govt. of India to allow the holders of B.H.M.S. Degree of University of Dhaka for admission into MD (Hom) courses at National Institute of Homoeopathy, Kolkata, so that Bangladesh may have sufficient trained and highly qualified Homoeopathic Doctors for the furtherance of Homoeopathy in the country. During the discussions, Dr. Samsul Hoque, Director (Alternative Medical Care) of Bangladesh was also present.

Director (A.M.C) apprised the team of experts about the status of Homoeopathic medical services as well as other Alternative medical system of medicine in Bangladesh.

The Indian Experts visited Bangladesh Homoeopathic Board at Dhaka and met the Chairman, Dr. Dilip Kumar Roy and discussed about the Homoeopathic practice, code of ethics and system of registration of Homoeopathic Practitioners in Bangladesh. The Chairman apprised the Indian team about the Homoeopathic education at the Diploma level and the status of Homoeopathic Medical Colleges recognized by it for running Diploma Courses. The Registrar, Dr. Md. Jahangir Alam, Controller of Examination, Dr. Ali Azzam Sk. and Members of the Bangladesh Homoeopathic Board namely, Dr. Ashish Neogi, Dr. Imrul Kayas, Dr. A.S.M. Raza-ur-Rahman, Dr. Aktar Jahan (Mily) were also present during the meeting.

The team also visited the University of Dhaka and met the Registrar, Syed Razaur Rahman and discussed about the Homoeopathic education in Bangladesh.

The team apprised the Registrar about the status of Homoeopathic education and research in India. During the discussions, the Deputy Registrar, University of Dhaka, Chairman and Registrar of Bangladesh Homoeopathic Board were also present.

The team visited the factory of a leading Homoeopathic medicine manufacturer of Bangladesh (Maxfair & Company Limited) at Dhamsona (Sreepur), Ashulia, which is also an exporter of Homoeopathic Medicine.

It manufactures Homoeopathic medicines following the Homoeopathic Pharmacopoeia of India (HPI) and Homoeopathic Pharmacopoeia of United States (HPUS).
