MEETINGS OF CCH AND ITS COMMITTEES

One meeting of Central Council, 2 meetings of Executive Committee, 2 meetings of Education Committee, 1 meeting of P.G. The Central Council inspected 40 Homoeopathic Medical Colleges during the period under report to monitor the extent of minimum required facilities and standards of education are met by them.
