MEETINGS OF CCH AND ITS COMMITTEE

During the period from April 2014 - June 2014 different Committees held their respective meetings including 2 meetings of Executive Committee, 2 meetings of Education Committee, 1 meeting of P.G. Education Committee, 1 meeting of Excellence in Education Committee, 1 meeting of Literature Committee, 2 meetings of Liaison Committee, 1 meeting of Registration Committee, 3 meetings of Sub - Committee [2 related to Website and 1 regarding to finalize the amendments to Homoeopathy (Post Graduates Degree Course) Regulations].

DIRECT REGISTRATION BY C.C.H.

The Central Council received 154 applications for Direct Registration from the Homoeopathic Practitioner holding recognized medical qualification and registration with the State Boards / Councils, and it has issued Direct Registration Certificate to 112 applicants and also issued 1 Duplicate Certificate to one applicant. It also registered Additional qualification of 5 applicants in the Central Register.

INSPECTION OF HOMOEOPATHIC MEDICAL COLLEGES

Central Council of Homoeopathy inspected 36 Homoeopathic Medical Colleges during the period under report to monitor the extent the minimum required facilities standards of education are met by them.
