DIRECT REGISTRATION BY C.C.H.

The Central Council received 153 applications for Direct Registration holding recognized medical qualification and registration with the State Boards / Councils, and it has issued Direct Registration Certificate to 153 applicants. Additional qualification of nine practitioners was included in the records of Central Council.

Central Register containing 13488 names in Part I and Part II, has been sent to Govt. Publication Department on 02.09.2014 for publication in the Official Gazette.
