
WORKSHOP ON SURGERY

Central Council of Homoeopathy organized two days workshop on the subject of 'SURGERY' for the teachers of Homoeopathic Medical Colleges in the States of Assam, Arunachal Pradesh, Bihar, Chandigarh, Chattisgarh, Delhi, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Rajasthan, Uttrakhand, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh from 21st May to 22nd May, 2015 at New Delhi.

The objectives of workshop were:

- 1. improvement of quality of education in Homoeopathy; and
- 2. to promote skills and techniques in teaching.



MEETINGS OF COMMITTEES OF CCH

During the period from April, 2015 - June, 2015, different Committees of CCH held their respective meetings including 1 meeting of Executive Committee, 2 meetings of Office Functioning Review Committee, 1 meeting of Committee on Excellence in Education in Homoeopathy, 1 meeting of Chairmen of all the Committees of Central Council of Homoeopathy chaired by the President of the Council, 1 meeting of Registration Committee and 1 meeting of Rajbhasa Committee.

DIRECT REGISTRATION BY C.C.H.

The Central Council has received 128 applications for direct registration from practitioners holding recognised medical qualification and registration with the State Boards/Councils and it has issued direct registration Certificate to 100 applicants, during the period.

Work related to 14693 names of West Bengal (Part - I) and Direct Registered practitioners has been completed in all respect for taking into Central Register. Names of 147 practitioners of Part - I fo Central Register notified in 1993 as well as Part - II of Central Register notified in 1996 have been restored and sent to Controller of Govt. Publications for notification in Official Gazette. About 12000 names of State Register of Bihar (Part I) have been completed for taking in to the Central Register.

INSPECTION OF HOMOEOPATHIC MEDICAL COLLEGES

The Central Council inspected 11 Homoeopathic Medical Colleges during the period under report to monitor the extent of compliance of minimum required facilities and standards of education by them.

TRAINING OF STAFF OF CCH

Central Council organized a training programme in view of the decision of its Rajbhasha Karyanwayan Samiti wherein Shri Jaswant Singh, Junior Hindi Translator - cum - Head Clerk did the needful for training to all L.D.Cs of the Council on Rajbhasha Act and related Quarterly Report, on 17.04.2015.
