The workshop was organized to discuss various aspects of the methodology, practical difficulties encountered while conducting Drug Proving Programme, comparing methodology with those of the international homoeopathic organizations, conducting a few pilot studies by including immunological, enzymatic, endocrinal, electro-physiological parameters to make Drug Proving Research more objective and scientific. The participants of the workshop were Research personnels of CCRH, Principals and faculty members of the colleges engaged in the Drug Proving Programme.

### INSPECTION OF HOMOEOPATHIC MEDICAL COLLEGES

The Central Council of Homoeopathy inspected 20 Homoeopathic Medical Colleges during the period under report (from April to June 2010) to assess the facilities and standards of education.

During the period from April to June 2010, total 8 meetings of different Committees of Central Council of Homoeopathy were held which include 2 meetings of Executive Committee, 1 meeting of Education Committee, 1 meeting of P.G. Education Committee, 1 meeting of Committee for Excellence in Education in Homoeopathy, 1 meeting of Office Functioning Review Committee, 1 meeting of Regulation Committee and 1 meeting of Raj Bhasa Committee.

### CENTRAL REGISTER OF HOMOEOPATHY

The Central Council of Homoeopathy published Central Register of Homoeopathy (VIII<sup>th</sup> volume) in the Official Gazette of Govt. of India on 24<sup>th</sup> April 2010. About 4000 practitioners of the States namely Assam, Arunachal Pradesh, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Rajasthan, Meghalaya (including those directly registered with the Council up to August 2009) have been included in it.

The Council issued direct registration certificates to 131 applicants during the period from April to June 2010.

on all working days and such a peripheral OPD may have at-least one Medical Officer, one Pharmacist/Dispenser, one Nurse/Aya and one attendant along with interns and P.G. students (P.G. students if the college is running P.G. Courses).

## CCH PRESIDENT PERTICIPATED IN THE MEETING OF U.G.C

Dr. Ramjee Singh, President of the Council participated in the two days meeting of Standing Committee of University Grants Commission held on 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> June, 2010 at New Delhi to discuss about specification of Degrees offered by the various educational institutions in India. The Committee reviewed the existing nomenclature of Degrees and considered the fresh proposals received for the specifications of Degrees. President, CCH urged UGC to

notify M.D. (Hom) qualification in seven speciality subjects as indicated in the P.G. Degree Course Regulations which has been informed earlier vide Council's letter bearing No. 14-9/2008 -CCH dated 26.10.2009. He also requested the Commission to denotify MHMS qualification which is not recognized in terms of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973, which too was objected in a letter of CCH earlier.
