The Central Council of Homoeopathy inspected 34 Homoeopathic Medical Colleges during the period under report (from July to September, 2011) to assess the extent the minimum required facilities and standards of education are met.

CCH PRESIDENT MET HEALTH MINISTER OF ODISHA

President of the Central Council, Dr. Ramjee Singh, along with Dr. K.K. Kar and Dr. L.K. Nanda, Members and Secretary, Dr. Lalit Verma met the Hon'ble Minister of Health & Family Welfare, Shri Prasanna Kumar Acharya on 11th August, 2011. Smt. Anu Garg, Commissioner cum Secretary, Department of Health & Family Welfare and Director, AYUSH of the State were also present.

During discussions, President of the Council, Dr. Ramjee Singh expressed the concern of the Council for insufficient number of teaching staff in the cadres of Professor, Reader and Lecturer in Homoeopathic Medical Colleges run by the State Govt. President stressed upon the State Govt. to fill up the vacant posts in any case before Oct. 2011.

During the meeting, the following issues were discussed -

- 1) The medical education in Homoeopathy in the State of Odisha is also imparted through private Homoeopathic Medical Colleges which had been established with the consent of the State Govt.; therefore, the State Govt. needs to ensure fulfillment of minimum prescribed requirements and norms by these colleges, also before Oct. 2011.
- 2) The State Govt. has to ensure that all the colleges conducting BHMS and MD(Hom) courses in the State of Odisha (whether Govt. or private) besides the minimum prescribed teaching faculty, must also fulfill the other prescribed norms in terms of accommodation, hospital staff, equipment, library, facilities for clinical training etc. as prescribed by the Central Council of Homoeopathy.
- 3) The attention of the State authorities was also drawn to the poor functioning of the State Board of Homoeopathy at Bhubaneswar which has been constituted by the State Govt. The post of Registrar is vacant; the office of the State Board does not have any supporting staff. The State Board has no money even for meeting the postal expenses. The State Board has not furnished the State Register of Homoeopathy after March 1988 in a proper manner.
